# Whitewater CofE Primary School – Reducing risk from COVID-19

## Information for visitors and building users

We currently have increased precautions in place to minimise the risk of disease transmission during the COVID-19 pandemic. Please read this document before entering our school. The full risk assessment can be requested at the school office or is available on the school website.

**All users of the building are asked to follow the controls below:**

### Do

- ✓ use hand sanitiser gel before entering the school building
- ✓ wash your hands with soap and water regularly or use hand sanitiser gel – do this for at least 20 seconds
- ✓ use, 'Stop, Look, Go' when moving around the school building
- ✓ keep socially distant from members of staff and children and/or wear a face covering if distancing cannot be maintained
- ✓ clean surfaces and objects you have been in contact with, before leaving a room
- ✓ cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- ✓ put used tissues in the lidded bins straight away and wash your hands afterwards
- ✓ follow the advice of school staff and notify the office immediately if you feel unwell



### Do not

- X enter the school if you feel unwell or display any of the COVID-19 symptoms
- X touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean
