

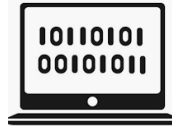
History



Our learning will involve a study of the Anglo-Saxon way of life, a revision of settlement and the legacy left behind following invasion by the Vikings.

PSHE:

Maths:

Our initial focus will be on revising and learning number and place value and improving mental mathematics strategies to complete calculations using the four operations, including the learning and recall of multiplication and corresponding division facts to 12 multiplied by 12 and 144 divided by 12. Learning and skills will be consolidated and extended through fluency, problem solving and reasoning activities.

English:

Our initial theme is how authors tell more than one story in a text and we will be learning, consolidating and extending our skills as narrative writers through authors such as Oliver Jeffreys and David Wiesner. We will also be our persuasive writing skills to ask for the pet of our dreams.

DT:

We will be learning about the seasonality of foods and creating, refining and evaluation recipes which include a balance of ingredients.

Art:

Fox Class will be studying the work and influence of Andy Goldsworthy in the context of natural art using the form of sculpture and the mediums of salt dough and natural resources
