Online Safety

The Internet Watch Foundation (IWF) tells us that 'since the start of the pandemic, the amount of 'selfgenerated' child abuse imagery has increased dramatically. In 2020, the IWF confirmed 68,000 cases of such imagery, a rise of 77% on the year before. It accounts for nearly half (44%) the imagery we took action on last year. In 80% of these cases, the victims were 11- to 13-year-old girls.' The IWF has created a resource to help parents and
