Day 2 To answer questions on the text (Part 1)	In this lesson, we will use the text to retrieve and infer answers to questions about chapter 3 - Whiter than White. Day 3 To analyse characters	In this lesson, we will explore the main characters in the text in more detail. Our main focus is on Miss Root, the new dentist, and the impression of her that we get as we read about her actions and the way in which the previous dentist died. For some people the violent death of the previous dentist will be a sensitive topic. If this applies to you, you may want to do the lesson with an adult.
