- ✓ Contact parents if there is a persistent issue surrounding attendance or punctuality
- ✓ Contact parents as soon as possible if the school has concerns about a child's learning, behaviour or progress
- ✓ Set, give feedback and monitor home learning regularly in keeping with the school's policy
- ✓ Provide extra-curricular clubs to inspire children and develop a variety of skills
