

## Some useful things to have at home!

- A pack of balloons - use them for balloon football, tennis, keepy uppy games, without damaging the house!
- Items for junk modelling.
- A pack of cards - there are lots of games you can play such as Snap or Donkey.
- A lined notebook and a plain notebook - useful for writing, drawing and carrying out school tasks if applicable.
- Colouring pens, ruler, pencils and/or paints
- Craft kits, readily available from the Works, Hobbycraft etc.

- Playdough/modelling clay, or you can find recipes to make your own dough.
- Colouring books/sticker books

- Coloured thread and/or beads for making friendship bracelets, necklaces or bag tags.
- Skipping rope.
- Seeds and compost to get children growing outdoors.
